- Supported MFR agency enrolments with in-person discussions in Grande Prairie, Nanton, Mountainview County, Cardston, Forty Mile County, Wheatland County, County of Wetaskiwin, Irma, City of Red Deer, Red Deer County, Parkland County and Onoway regions
- **Fifty** agencies started the MFR enrolment process in the month of December
- **Ninety** individual MFRs received con-ed credits for attending EMS Clinical Symposiums in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2015
- Promoted awareness of the MFR Program among frontline EMS staff during Clinical Symposiums in Calgary (Dec 08) and Red Deer (Dec 11 & 14)
- **\$59,802** of clinical equipment & training supports directly distributed among enrolled MFR agencies to date
- Continued work to include MFR MCPs on mobile app (IOS and Android)
- Finalized design of MFR Patch/PCR guide memo pad and placed a printing order
- Completed testing of online training area and launched that section of the MFR portal
- Evaluated first batch of applications for the MFR Training & Equipment Fund
- Drafted potential changes for MFR MCPs to include administration of Naloxone by EMT practitioners, these changes are pending further approval and educational resources
