### Activity for previous period

- Supported MFR agency enrolments with in-person discussions in Edmonton, Parkland County, Foothills County, Claresholm, Onoway, Bashaw, Killam, Flagstaff County, Blairmore, Nobleford, Coaldale and Champion regions
- **\$149,958** of clinical equipment & training supports directly distributed among enrolled MFR agencies to date
- Published MFR MCPs on the provincial AHS EMS app (IOS and Android)
- Closed the MFR Training & Equipment Fund on Jan 31, evaluated all applications with 40 agencies to receive support for patient care-related priorities
- Registered the MFR Program to participate in the [AFCA annual conference and trade show](#) May 29-Jun 01, 2016 in Calgary
- Began work to implement online Naloxone Administration training module on [www.AlbertaMFR.ca](http://www.AlbertaMFR.ca)
- Began planning implementation of MFR response plans batch #2
- Delivered MFR update presentation to Alberta Health on Jan 22
- Began distributing MFR Patch/PCR guide memo pads for on-scene use
- Began planning for Medical Priority Dispatch System (MPDS) v.13 code update
- January saw the largest monthly increase to date in number of new MFR portal users (34%)
