'Introduction to Goals of Care Designations' training is now available on [AlbertaMFR.ca](#). This free online module introduces the Goals of Care Designations (GCD) and the "green sleeve" responders may encounter at the patient's side. This is important information for the MFR role in honouring the patient's wishes for their care. GCD will eventually replace "Do Not Resuscitate" orders throughout Alberta. The online training module includes a video presentation, images, samples and a self-assessment quiz with descriptive scenarios. All responders are encouraged to complete the Introduction to GCD training.
